GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the May 26, 2020 Order ("Order") of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the May 20, 2020 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Santa Barbara County ("Court"), this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Any Judge of the Court may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than an additional 30 days, applicable only to cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire from June 16, 2020, through July 16, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, \$68116(1)(10): Executive Order N-38-20 (03-27-20)
- 2. The Court may conduct trials at an earlier date, if able to do so in compliance with applicable health and safety laws, regulations, and orders, including the use of remote technology.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
