STIPULATION OF WAIVER OF TIME AND PERSONAL APPEARANCE OF DEFENDANT			CASE NUMBER:

The above-named defendant hereby stipulates that having been advised of his or her right to be present at all stages of the proceedings, including, but not limited to, presentation of and arguments on questions of fact and law, and to be confronted by and cross-examine all witnesses, the defendant hereby waives the right to be present at the hearing of any motion or other proceeding in this cause. Through counsel (pursuant to Emergency Rule 5 of the Judicial Council of California), the defendant hereby requests the court to proceed during every absence of the defendant that the court may permit pursuant to this waiver, and hereby agrees that his or her interest is represented at all times by the presence of his or her attorney the same as if the defendant were personally present in court, and further agrees that notice to his or her attorney that his or her presence in court on a particular day at a particular time is required is notice to the defendant of the requirement of his or her appearance at that time and place.

Pursuant to Emergency Rule 5 of the Judicial Council of California, Counsel represents that this waiver of personal appearance has been fully discussed with the defendant and the defendant has authorized counsel to proceed as counsel represents to the court through this stipulation.

Counsel stipulates that the defendant waives the following rights (check all that apply):

- right to have a preliminary hearing within 10 court days of arraignment;
- right to have a preliminary hearing within 60 days of arraignment;
