NOTICE TO PROBATIONER

Thoroughly familiarize yourself with the conditions of probation, as a violation of any of the terms of probation will render you liable to the following penalties, while if you faithfully perform your duties, you will be entitled to the privileges set forth below.

If the victim restitution or restitution fines are unpaid at 120 days prior to your probation expiration date, you must prepare and file a new updated financial disclosure form with the court no later than 90 days prior to the probation expiration date pursuant to section 1202.4 PC.

PENALTIES

At any time during your probation term, if the Court determines that you have violated any of the terms of your probation or have engaged in any criminal practice, or have become abandoned to improper associates, it may revoke and terminate your probation and pronounce judgment (Fine and/or Jail). (Penal Code section 1203.2)

PRIVILEGES

TO HAVE THE CONVICTION SET ASIDE. Defendant may, upon satisfactory completion of these terms of probation, request of the Court that his/her conviction be set aside, subject to certain limitations. (Penal Code section 1203.4)

TO HAVE THE RECORDS OF CONVICTION OF MINORS SEALED. Where the defendant was under the age of 18 years at the time of the commission of a misdemeanor, and where the defendant was not convicted of more than one offense, with certain limitations, the defendant may request that the Court order sealing of the records of convictions. (Penal Code section 1203.45)

APPEAL RIGHTS

You have the right to appeal the judgment imposed in this case. If you choose to appeal you must file a "Notice of Appeal" with this Court within 30 days of the date judgment is pronounced. If you wish to be represented by any attorney and cannot afford one, you must notify the Court that you wish counsel appointed. It is your responsibility to inform the Court of any address change.
